VRP Program Summary

This program is designed to reactivate NYS vacant housing stock. Property owners receive grant funds for essential renovations to transform vacant housing units into ready-to-occupy homes.

Receive up to \$50k per unit for rental limit at 80% AMI Receive up to \$75k per unit for rental limit at 60% AMI

Property Eligibility Criteria

Properties located on the Eastside of Buffalo in the following zip codes: 14204 - 14206 - 14208 - 14209 - 14210 - 14211 - 14212 - 14214 - 14215; with boundaries identified as Main Street to the north and west, I-190 and Kaisertown to the south, and Cheektowaga to the east.

One to five unit homes in residential, mixed use & conversions

Property must be vacant and unmarketable before the time of application and not made vacant for the purpose of applying

Property must be properly insured

Proposed scope of work can be completed within grant amount

Upon completion of program the property must be ready to rent

Property taxes, utilities, and loans must be current

Applicant Eligibility Criteria

Property owner resides in Buffalo, Eastside preferred

Property owner owns and/or has control over less than 20 housing units, combined

Property owner demonstrates responsible ownership through maintenance of controlled properties, lack of reported complaints, lack of instances of litigation initiated by tenants or any other entity, lack of foreclosure, violations and/or bankruptcy

Must complete a site visit of the applying property with a designated East Buffalo Development facilitator

10-year lien Declaration for capped rent, will be transferred to any buyer within regulation period

Rent capped: 80%AMI max is below:

(subject to change based on location and utility allowance) Studio = \$1,279; 1 Bd = \$1,344, 2 Bd = \$1,605, 3 Bd = \$1,843

Rent capped: 60%AMI max is below:

(subject to change based on location and utility allowance) Studio = \$940; 1 Bd = \$980, 2 Bd = \$1,169, 3 Bd = \$1,339

Yearly rent certification with submission of lease

Compliance with 10-year ongoing monitoring

Property must be rented within 6 months of program completion
